CLEVELAND, OH - The 2012 nonprofit fundraising season kicks off on Saturday, January 28, 2012, at the Western Reserve Historical Society History Center in University Circle where guests break through to a 1960s revolution, and party the night away under psychedelic lights while dancing to the groovy tunes of the '60s.
