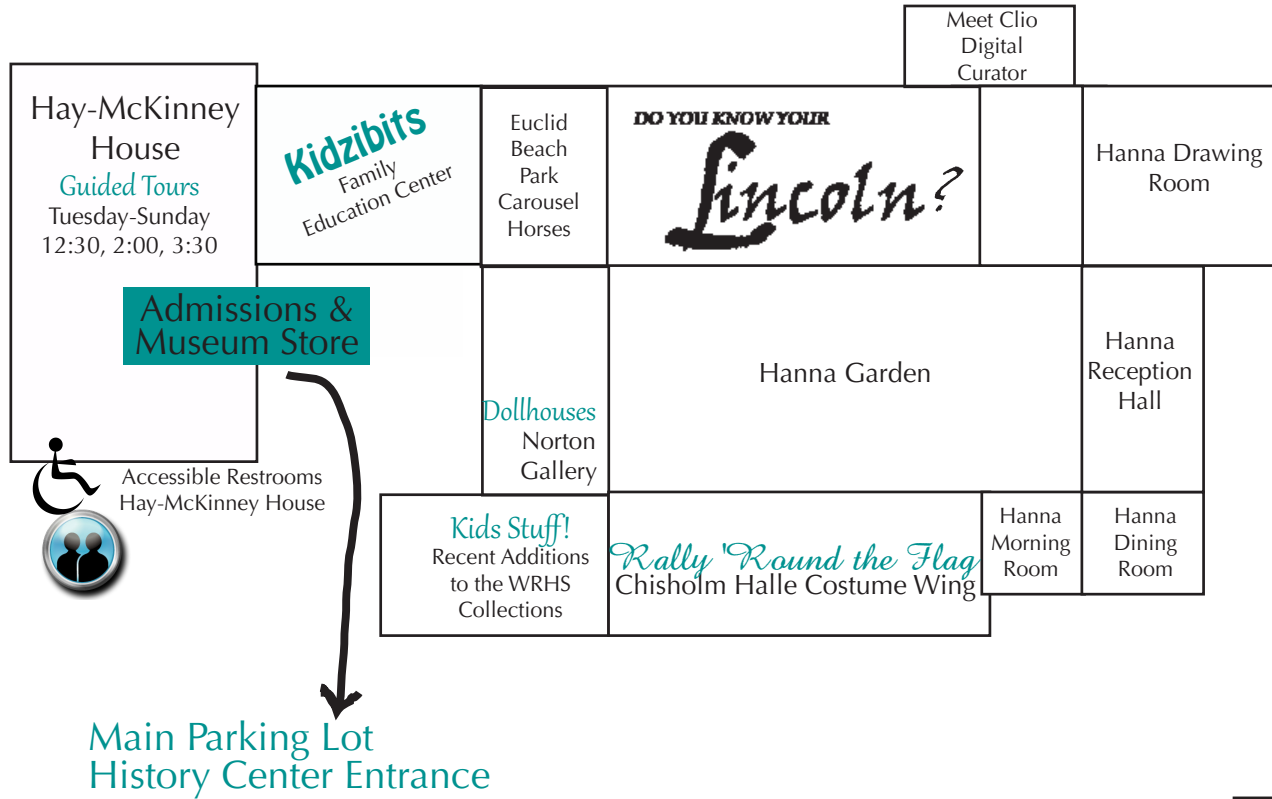

The Crawford Galleries are closed... Here's what is going on

A \$3 million construction project is underway at the WRHS History Center in University Circle. When it is completed by September 2012, visitors will arrive to a more open, bright and welcoming space with new layout, flooring, lighting, ADA accessible bathrooms, gift shop and climate control systems. New staircases will create a stronger connection to the museum's lower level and a new elevator will connect the two floors of the Crawford exhibit area to the adjacent historic Bingham-Hanna House and adjoining exhibit galleries. Equally important in this mostly state-funded project will be the work to ensure the integrity of the museum and protection of the collections, including a new roof, ceilings, electrical, insulation and sprinkler system.
